

A meeting of the State Lands Commission was held in Room 302, State Building, Los Angeles, December 8, 1943, at 1:00 P.M.

1. The minutes of the meeting of the State Lands Commission held in Sacramento, November 4, 1943, were upon motion of Mr. Houser, seconded by Chairman Hassler, unanimously approved and confirmed.

2. After being informed that a typographical error had been made in Item 8 of the minutes of August 25, 1943, upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted correcting this item by deletion of the word Operator, in Line 4, so that this resolution will read as follows:

"Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted giving approval to the request dated August 5, 1943 of H. R. Hamilton, Operator and F. E. Fairfield, Partner to assign as of July 10, 1943, an undivided one third interest to H. R. Hamilton, an undivided one third interest to the O. C. Field Gasoline Corporation," etc.

3. (Easement No. 415, Standard Oil Company) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving the 38th revision of the Rio Vista Acreage Allocation, which revision results in an increase to 10.114% allocation to State land. This approval is granted subject to any change which might result in necessary adjustments of the basic acreage figure to be agreed upon with respect to the 11th and 12th revisions, and further subject to the Standard Oil Company agreeing to extend the time within which the State might make formal objection to the 11th to 38th revisions, inclusive, of the State's percentage allotment to 60 days after the submission by Standard Oil Company to the Commission of the revised map of the Rio Vista Field which the Standard Oil Company has agreed to submit.

4. (Withdrawal and Readvertising of Elwood Field Extension) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted approving the actions of the Executive Officer in withdrawing the notice of intention to receive bids for an area of submerged lands at Elwood, Santa Barbara County. The notice was advertised on October 19, 1943. The Resolution also authorized the readvertising of this area.
