- 13. (Permit for Temporary Telephone Line Crossing to Standard Oil Company No. 137, P.R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the issuance of a temporary ninety day permit to Standard Oil Company for construction of a temporary telephone line across Middle River from McDonald Island to Mandeville Island. This permit to be subject to the payment of a \$5.00 filing fee and at no rental charge and further subject to the understanding that should a permanent installation be made a right-of-way easement for the lands will be obtained.
- 14. (Application for a Forty-Eight Inch Salt Water Intake Line Standard Oil Company, No. 139, P.R.C.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the issuance of a fifteen year right-of-way across tide and submerged lands in Contra Costa County for construction and maintenance of a forty-eight inch salt water intake line by the Standard Oil Company at an annual rental of \$40.00 plus two cents per lineal foot.
- 15. (Permit to Construct a Pier at Half Moon Bay Romeo Fish Company, No. 138, P.R.C) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing issuance of a fifteen year permit to construct and maintain a six hundred foot wooden pier over tide and submerged lands at Half Moon Bay, San Mater County. The monthly rental charge for occupancy of State land by this pier shall be one quarter of a cent per pound on all fish moved over the wharf with a guaranteed minimum of \$30.00 per month. It is understood that this rental shall not include any charge for sardines and anchovies up to twenty-f.ve tons per year. Should said quantity of sardines and anchovies exceed twenty-five tons per year, the rental charge therefor shall be mutually agreed upon.
- 16. (Proposed Change in Salary Classification Virginia L. Pyle) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to request the Personnel Board to change the classification of Miss Pyle from Junior Stenographer-Clerk to Intermediate Stenographer-Clerk with a salary of \$110 plus \$25.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was recessed until such time as the Commission may make the inspection of the Rincon Field, and reconvene at the call of the Chairman.
