- 17. (Abolition of Junior Petroleum Engineering Aid and Establishment in Lieu thereof of Junior Civil Engineer and/or Geological Draftsman) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted abolishing the position of Junior Petroleum Engineering Aid in Los Angeles and the establishment in lieu thereof of a Junior Civil Engineer and/or Geological Draftsman. A salary of \$210. plus \$25. per month Emergency Increase, was authorized for this position.
- 18. (La Tour State Forest) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted instructing the Executive Officer to advise the Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry, that the State Lands Commission has no intention of selling the School land in the La Tour State Forest, or the timber on such land.
- 19. (Ponner Lake) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted instructing the Executive Officer to request the Attorney General to institute an action for Declaratory Judgment, (Section 1060, Civil Code), in order to determine conclusively that the State of California is the owner of the bed of Donner Lake below the low water mark.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
