Carroll and Frusitta & Purinton a five year grazing lease on 280 acres of land contained within the No of NW1, SE of NW1, NW1 of NE1, SE of NE1, No of SE of Section 36, T. 15 S., R. 11 E., M.D.W. Such lease is to be subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Payment in advance of the annual rental of twenty cents per acre.
 - b. Payment in advance of the last year's rental at the time of execution of the lease.
- 14. (Assignment of Grazing Lease No. P.R.C. 1005) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission authorized the Executive Officer to approve the assignment from J. J. (Sale of Vacant Lieu Land, Location No. 4541, Secramento Land District, to Division of Highways) Upon motion duly made and unant-mously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale for \$1,135.73 cash of the Wa of NWA of SEL of NEL and Wa of Wa of Fa of NWA of SEL of NEL of NEL of Section 26, T. 29 N., R. 3 E., M.D.M. to the Division of Highways, The sale to be subject to statutory reservations including minerals.
- 16. (School Land Lease No. P.R.C. 67 San Bernardino County- War Department) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to execute with the Federal Government a duration lease on 320 acres of land contained within the Wg of Section 36, T. 6 N., R. 3 E., S.B.M., San Bernardino County for a consideration of \$9.60 per year. The lease is to be effective March, 1942 to June 30, 1943 with a right of renewal from year to year at the option of the Federal Government, provided that there be no extension beyond six months of termination of the unlimited National Emergency.
