26. (Cancellation of Grazing Lease No. P.R.C: 1127 - David E. Ullery) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission authorized the Executive Officer to cancel the grazing lease previously authorized by the Commission on May 5, 1944. Mr. Ullery has failed to pay the second annual rental which was due and payable on May 5, 1945. Inasmuch as Mr: Ullery paid the last year's rental at time of execution of the lease, the effective date of cancellation will be May 5, 1946.

27. (Fish Canyon Lease No. P.R.C. 1157 - George A. McKinney) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing ' the Executive Officer to execute a ten year lease with George A. McKinney, covering Lot 8 in Fish Conyon, subject to the condition that the Lessee will pay the first and last years' rental at the time of execution of the lease. (Rental is \$30.00 per year.)

28. (Fish Canyon Recreational Lease No. P.R.C. 1150) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to approve the application of Walter A. Sneuse to assign State Recreational Lease No. P.R.C. 1150, covering Let 37 in Fish Canyon, to Mr. H. P. Cox.

29. (Fish Canyon Recroational Lease No. P.R.C. 1145) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to approve the application of Richard F. Lutz to assign State Recreational Lease No. P.R.C. 1145, covering Let 22 in Fish Canyon, to Mr. Emil Vukasovic and Mrs. Mae Vukasovic.

30. (Application for Mineral Lease - E¹/₂ of NW¹/₂ of Section 16, T. 16 S. R. 6 E., S.B.M.) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to advertise a notice of intention to receive bids for a mineral lease on oighty acros in the E¹/₂ of NW¹/₂ of Section 16, T. 16 S., R. 6 E., S.B.M., San Diego County. Lease will provide for extraction of lead, silver and such other minerals except oil and/or gas. Advertising shall contain notice that no bid will be accepted, if royalty to State is less than 16 2/3 per cent of the value of any mined material or minerals.

31. (Assignment of Lease No. P.R.C. 105 - Robert Cecil) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing' the Executive Officer to approve the assignment of Lease No. P.R.C. 105, covoring one and one-quarter acres in the SW2 of NW2 of Section 9, T. 1 N., R. 23 E., S.B.M., to Charles R. and Lela B. Johnson.

Approval of this assignment is upon the express condition that such assignment does not and shall not release or relieve the assigner from any obligation to the State under the terms of said lease, and that the State may hold the assigner liable for the faithful performance of any and all obligations of the lessee, under said lease, which was issued September 23, 1943 for a period of five years.
