

5. (Notice of Intention to Lease Tide and Submerged Lands for Oil Development - Santa Barbara Mesa) The Commission was informed by City Attorney Norris Montgomery, that the City Council of Santa Barbara expected to adopt the proposed Santa Barbara anti-drilling ordinance at the Council meeting on February 21, 1946.

The Commission, upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, deferred further action on this matter until the next Commission meeting.

6. (Deferment Request for Main Zone Well - Huntington State Company - No. P.R.C. 91) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the action of the Executive Officer relative to authorizing postponement until February 15, 1946 of the obligation to drill a Main Zone Well.

7. (Huntington State Company - No. P.R.C. 91 - Request for a New Well Location) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the action of the Executive Officer relative to a new bottom hole location of Well No. 24-A of this lessee.

8. (Application to Lease Tide and Submerged Lands on Carquinez Straits - Antone Dowdlic - No. P.R.C. 202) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing issuance of a fifteen year lease to Mr. Antone Dowdlic of Contra Costa County. Lease covers 4.4 acres of tide and submerged lands on Carquinez Straits, near Crockett, Contra Costa County at a total rent of \$15,000.00 for the fifteen year period commencing February 20, 1942. Conditions of issuance are as follows:

- a. Payment of the first and last years' rental (\$1,000.00 per annum) at time of execution of the lease.
- b. Filing of a \$5,000.00 performance bond.
