

5. (Permit for Underwater (Sub-sea) Geophysical Operations - No. P.R.C. 213) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission confirmed the action of the Executive Officer, whereunder a permit had been granted to Honolulu Oil Corporation for a sixty day period for the conducting of underwater geophysical operations upon State tide and submerged lands offshore from Seal Beach, Orange County.
