- 5. (Permit for Underwater (Sub-sea) Geophysical Operations No. P.R.C. 213) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission confirmed the action of the Executive Officer, whereunder a permit had been granted to Honolulu Oil Corporation for a sixty day period for the conducting of underwater geophysical operations upon State tide and submerged lands offshore from Seal Beach, Crange County.
- 6. (Lease of Tide and Submerged Lands in Morro Bay, San Luis Obispo County Messrs. Earl S. Roberts and L. F. Carver No. P.R.C. 207) The Commission was advised that the County officials of San Luis Obispo and Messrs, Earl S. Roberts and L. F. Carver had come to agreement in connection with the lease awarded to Messrs. Carver and Roberts on January 18, 1946.
