A meeting of the State Lands Commission was held in Room 301 State Building, Los Angeles, on March 18, 1946 at 2:30 P.M.

Present: Hororable James S. Dean, Chairman Honorable Frederick F. Houser, Member Honorable Thomas H. Kuchel, Member.

- 1. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the minutes of the meetings of the State Lands Commission held in Sacramento on Fanuary 18th and February 15th, 1946, were approved and confirmed as subsideed.
- 2. The next meeting of the Commission was tentatively scheduled to be held in Sacramento, on Saturday, April 13, 1946, at 10 A.M.
- 3. (Partiel Assignment State Oil and Gas Leans No. P.R.C. 91)
 Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the Commission
 authorized approval of partial assignment from H. R. Hamilton to
 T. H. Sherman of fifteen per cent of H. R. Hamilton's one third
 interest in that portion of the leasehold estate which has not been
 conveyed heretofore to Huntington State Company under approval by
 the State Lands Commission.

Approval of the assignment is subject to agreement by the Lesses and Assigness or any successors thereto to continue assumption of all liabilities and responsibilities for compliance with all terms, provisions and conditions of said Lease No. P.R.C. 91 and exhibits thereof.

4. (Notice of Intention to Lease Tide and Submerged Lands for Oil Pevilopment - Santa Barbara Mesa) The Commission was informed that the City of Santa Barbara had passed ordinances which will become effective April 7, 1946, prohibiting oil drilling on the area within the City of Santa Barbara known as Santa Barbara Mesa.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried. the Commission adopted a resolution rescinding the previous Cormission action on April 7, 1944 authorizing the advertising for bids of the tide and submerged area offshore from Santa Barbara Yesa.
