30. (Administration - Transfer of Funds) The recommendation of the State Controller dated May 15, 1946 was read wherein it was requested that the sum of \$750,000.00 be transferred from the State Lands Act Fund to the General Fund, State Beach Fund, and State Park Fund in proportions of 30%, 23 1/3% and 46 2/3% respectively. Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing this transfer.

31. (Proposed National Association of Public Land Officials) The Commission was informed that an organization of public land officials for the purpose of protecting State's rights on land matters has been formed on a tentative basis and that a conference thereof is to be held at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on July 22, 1946, to perfect the association and to prepare for hearings in Congress on public land matter:

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Acting Executive Officer to represent the Commission at the scheduled meeting of the national association of public land officials on July 22, 1946 at Santa Fe, New Mexico.

32. (Sale of Vacant School Land - Application No. 10319 -Edwin Dingle Los Angeles Land District - San Bernardino County) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale of Section 16, T. 1 S., R. 6E., S. B. M., containing 640 acres in San Bernardino County to Edwin J. Dingle at a cash price of \$2,560.00. Mr. Dingle was the only bidder pursuant to the advertising. The land is to be sold subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.

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
