

8. (Request for Cancellation of Application - Silver Strand Skyport Syndicate - San Diego County - Lease No. P.R.C. 243) The Commission was informed of the request made by the Silver Strand Skyport Syndicate for cancellation of their application for a lease of filled-in tide and submerged lands adjacent to the Silver Strand, San Diego County, for the reason that they have been unsuccessful in obtaining the requisite permits for the construction and operation of an airport on the State lands.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to cancel the application of the Silver Strand Skyport Syndicate for Lease No. P.R.C. 243 and to refund the deposit of \$445.00 made in connection with said application.

9. (Agreement Arbitrating Ordinary High Water Mark - Fibreboard Products, Inc., - Contra Costa County - W.O. No. 70) The Commission was informed of the survey completed by the Commission's staff of the ordinary high water mark along the southerly side of the San Joaquin River, which is the boundary of lands owned in fee by the Fibreboard Products, Inc., made in connection with the application of said company for use and occupancy of tide and submerged lands in the San Joaquin River near Antioch, Contra Costa County, for construction of a pipe line and plant facilities.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to execute an agreement with Fibreboard Products, Inc., establishing by arbitration, pursuant to Section 6357 of the Public Resources Code, the line of ordinary high water as surveyed and determined by the staff of the Commission, as the fixed boundary between the fee lands of the Fibreboard Products, Inc., and the tidelands of the State.

10. (Application for Dredging - American Dredging Company - Contra Costa County - W.O. No. 85, P.R.C. 330) The Commission was informed of the application received from the American Dredging Company requesting permission to dredge an access channel on State tide and submerged land at McAvoy, Contra Costa County, to provide an entrance to a series of boat berthing basins to be dredged wholly on privately-owned uplands, the statutory \$5.00 filing fee and a deposit in the amount of \$450.00 to cover costs of the Commission in establishing the ordinary high water mark as the boundary between the State lands and the privately-owned uplands, having been submitted by the applicant.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the Executive Officer to grant permission to the American Dredging Company to dredge and maintain an entrance channel on State tide and submerged lands to berthing basins to be dredged on privately-owned uplands at McAvoy, Contra Costa County, for the consideration of the statutory \$5.00 filing fee deposited heretofore.
