

21. (Sale of Vacant Federal Land, Obtained through Use of Base, Selection No. 10397, Los Angeles Land District - Riverside County - Elizabeth E. Estle) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the filing for $W\frac{1}{2}$ and $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15 and $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, T. 7 S., R. 21 E., S.B.M., containing 640 acres in Riverside County, with the Federal Government and approving, subject to the approval of the selection by the General Land Office, the sale of the said land in Riverside County to Elizabeth E. Estle at a cash price of \$3,200.00, subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

22. (Sale of Vacant Federal Land, Obtained through Use of Base, Selection No. 10398, Los Angeles Land District - Riverside County - L. S. Estle) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the filing for $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, $S\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 9 and $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, T. 6 S., R. 22 E., S.B.M., containing 640 acres in Riverside County, with the Federal Government and approving, subject to the approval of the selection by the General Land Office, the sale of the said land in Riverside County to L. S. Estle at a cash price of \$3,200.00, subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

23. (Sale of Vacant Federal Land Obtained through Use of Base, Selection No. 10399, Los Angeles Land District - Riverside County - Hewlings Mumper) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the filing for $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and $E\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 35, T. 6 S., R. 21 E., and Lots 1 and 2 of the $NE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T. 7 S., R. 21 E., S.B.M., containing 640 acres in Riverside County, with the Federal Government and approving, subject to the approval of the selection by the General Land Office, the sale of the said land in Riverside County to Hewlings Mumper at a cash price of \$3,200.00, subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.

24. (Acquisition of Federal Land in National Forest, Obtained through Exchange of State Land in National Forest- Santa Barbara County) The Commission was informed of an inquiry received from Mr. L. R. Morris of San Luis Obispo County relative to the purchase of the $N\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28, $N\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29, $N\frac{1}{2}$ and $SW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, and $W\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 31, T. 11 N., R. 31 W., S.B.M., containing 1,440 acres in Santa Barbara County. This land may be obtained by the State from the Federal Government through exchange of equivalent acreage or value of State land within a National Forest. The State-acquired land would be excluded from the National Forest and made available for sale to the highest bidder for cash. Mr. Morris will apply for this acquired land when title is in the State.

The Commission was further informed that the Federal Regional Forester in San Francisco is interested in acquiring Section 16, T. 19 S., R. 2 E., M.D.M., containing 640 acres in Monterey County; the $N\frac{1}{2}$ and $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 38, T. 28 N., R. 8 E., M.D.M., containing 480 acres in Lassen County; and Section 16, T. 39 N., R. 12 E., M.D.M., containing 640 acres in Modoc County. Appraisal of the State land and Federal land involved in this suggested exchange has not been made, but will have to be made before consummation of negotiations.
