- 31. (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 10411, Los Angeles Land District San Bernardino County Ella S. Gudelj) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale of Section 16, T. 9 N., R. 1 W., S.B.M., containing 640 acres in San Bernardino County at a cash price of \$1,280.00 to Mrs. Gudelj who was the single bidder pursuant to the advertising. The land is to be sold subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.
- 32. (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 4637, Secremento Land District, Sierra County Mr. Frank B. Taylor) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale of the War and War of Eart of Section 16, T. 20 N., R. 17 E., M.D.M., containing 480 acres in Sierra County at a cash price of \$1,440.00 to Mr. Taylor who was the single hidder pursuant to the advertising. The land is to be sold subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.
- 33. (Sale of Vacant School Land, Application No. 4661, Sacramento Land District, San Luis Obispo County Tony Garcia) Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted authorizing the sale of Lot 4 of Section 36, T. 12 N., R. 28 N., S.B.M., containing 28.82 acres in San Luis Obispo County at a cash price of \$288.20 to Mr. Garcia who was the single bidder pursuant to the advertising. The land is to be sold subject to all statutory reservations including minerals.
- 34. (Application for Right of Way Easement, Shasta County and Trinity County Pacific Gas and Electric Company-P.R.C. 383) The Commission was informed that an application has been received from the Pacific Gas and Electric Company for a 75 foot Right of Way easement for the purpose of constructing, erecting, reconstructing, replacing, maintaining and using, for the transmission and distribution of electric energy a line of towers and such wires and cables as it may from time to time suspend therefore, together with a right of way therealong, over and across certain parcels of State school land in Section 36, T. 33 N., R. 9 W., Trinity County and in Section 36, T. 32 N., R. 6 W., M.D.B. & M., Shasta County, the right of way in three parcels totaling 3920 feet in length. Preliminary permit, subject to confirmation by the Commission, was granted April 1, 1947.

Upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, a resolution was adopted confirming the issuance of the permit and authorizing the Executive Officer to issue a 15 year right of way easement 75 feet in width to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company over the NE4 of the NE4 of Section 36, T. 33 N., R. 9 W., M.D.B. & M., a distance of 1500 feet in length; the SE4 of the SE4 of Section 36, T. 32 N., R. 6 W., M.D.B. & M., a distance of 1520 feet in length; and the NE4 of the NW4 of Section 36, T. 32 N., R. 6 W., M.D.B. & M., a distance of 900 feet in length, at an annual rental of \$118.40 in accordance with the established policy of the Commission, and permit said easement to be covered by the applicant's existing blanket bond.

35. (Cancellation of Utilization of Base within National Monument for Acquisition of Federal Public Domain Authorized March 19, 1948, 1. 0. 378) The Commission was informed that on March 19, 1948 authorization was given for the exchange with the Federal Government of approximately 108,000 acres and 43,000 acres of State school land within the Death Valley National Monument and the Joshua Tree National Monument, respectively, for approximately 120,000 acres of Federal lands at Camp Trwin, north and east of Barstow and approximately 9,000 acres of Federal land between Highway 99 and the Salton Sea, Tuperial County.
