approved by the Gammission heretofore, the last amendments having been approved on July 24, 1945. The Letter Agreement of extension as submitted by the lesses provides for extension of the contract terms from September 30, 1956 to September 30, 1951 unless terminated before that time on 30 days prior written notice by either party. No revision of the contract is proposed at this time.

AND RICHPIELD OIL CORPORATION TO WHICH CONTRACT PACIFIC WESTERN OIL CORPORATION SUCCEEDED IN INTEREST '9 OF MAY 31, 1946, AS THE BASIS FOR THE SALE AND DELIVERY BY THE PACIFIC WESTERN OIL CORPORATION OF ALL CIZ PRODUCED UNDER STATE OIL AND GAS LEASES P.R.C. 120 DATED SEPTEMBER 10, 1919 AND P.R.C. 123 DATED MOVEMBER 22, 1919, SUBJECT TO THE EXPRESS CONDITION THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE SALES CONTRACTS SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO MODIFY OR AFFECT IN ANY MANNER ANY OF THE LEASE TERMS INCLUDING FULL COMPLIANCE BY THE LESSEE WITH ALL THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF OIL AND GAS LEASES P.R.C. 120 AND P.R.C. 123 AND THE RULES AND RECULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

(agreement for easement no. L15. RIO vista, allothent revisions no. LL AND NO. 15 (POOL MASIS), STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA) The Commission was informed that the Standard Oil Company of California, as lessee under Agreement for Easement No. 415, Rio Vista, has submitted data relative to proposed revisions of the estimated productive limits of the pools within the field based upon the developments from the drilling of additional wells and current review of the productive capabilities of existing wells. Under the terms of the easement agreement proposed revisions of the productive limits of the field are subject to review by the State. The current proposed revisions have been reviewed by the staff and found to be a reasonable interpretation of the productive limits of the affacted pools based upon the available engineering data and processes for estimate of pool limits by the Rio Vista Allocation Committee. The proposed both revision would result in a minor decrease of State participating acreage in the East Midland Pool, minor decreases in the total limits of the East Midland and West Hamilton pools, and a minor increase in the total participating area of the East Emigh pool. The proposed lifth Revision would result in a minor increase in the total participating area of the West Hamilton pool. The specific data relating to these changes are tabalated herewith:

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE THE MATH REVISION (POOL BASIS) TO THE STATE'S ALLOTHENT OF PRODUCTIVE LANDS EFFECTIVE OCTOBER 13, 1950, AND THE LETH REVISION (POOL BASIS) EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 15, 1950, AS PRESENTED BY THE STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA ON DECEMBER 8 AND DECEMBER 14, 1950, RESPECTIVELY, PURSUANT TO AGREEMENT FOR EASENINT NO. 115.

9. (PROPOSED GAS LEASE, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AND BEDS OF NAVIGABLE RIVERS, SACRAMENTO AND SAN JOACOIN COUNTIES - W.O. 178) The Commission was informed that on November 21, 1919 the Commission authorized the publication of a notice of intention for a lease for the production of gas only from State lands contained within a specifically described tract lying in Sacramento and San Joaquin Counties in the vicinity of the City of Islaton based upon the extension of the Rio Vista Field by the completion of Well Islaton Community 1 and the potential additional extension by Well Gardner No. 5 then in the process of drilling. Subsequent developments in the area resulted in a considerable number of outlying non-productive wells. However, current results over a greater area than authorized heretofore as the exterior limits cor a proposed State gas lease have established five wells potentially capable of draining gas from State land.

Mr. Charles Ward appeared before the Commission on behalf of Brazos Oil and Gas Company, one of the prospective bidders and gave his approval of the proposed action except that his company would prefer the area be advertised for in two parcels, one for the Georgians Slough properties, the other for those adjoining the Sacramento River.
