1. UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS DECIDED TO ~~RESOLVE~~ SETTING A DATE FOR THE ~~NEXT COMMISSION MEETING~~.

2. (APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO OCCUPY ~~SUBMERGED~~ LAND AND TO CONSTRUCT PIER, LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, R. D. LANG - W.O. 1094, P.R.C. 687.) R. D. Lang has applied for a permit to occupy submerged land and to construct a pier 230 feet long and 5 feet wide in Lake Tahoe south of Lake Bay Post Office. A field survey is in process to locate the low-water line, the boundary between the state and the upland. Pending completion of this survey it has been concluded that issuance of a permit for a period of two years for the occupancy of submerged lands at an annual rental of \$10.00 is a practical solution of the problem of such applications. Filing fee and rental have been paid.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE TO R. D. LANG A PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, AND TO CONSTRUCT A PIER 230 FEET IN LENGTH AND 5 FEET IN WIDTH, TERM OF PERMIT TO BE TWO YEARS AT AN ANNUAL RENTAL OF \$10.00, PAID IN ADVANCE, WITH PRICE RIGHT TO TRY, ISSUANCE OF AN AGREEMENT FOR THE USE OF THE SAME AREA AT SUCH TERMS AS MAY BE DETERMINED AT THE END OF THE TWO-YEAR PERIOD.

3. (APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO OCCUPY SUBMERGED LAND AND TO CONSTRUCT PIER, LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, L. R. WIESLANDER - W.O. 1093, P.R.C. 688.) L. R. Wieslander has applied for a permit to occupy submerged land and to construct a pier 91 feet long and 5 feet wide in Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County, southwest of Tahoe City. A field survey is in process to locate the low-water line, the boundary between the State and the upland. Pending completion of this survey it has been concluded that issuance of a permit for a period of two years for the occupancy of submerged lands at an annual rental of \$10.00 is a practical solution of the problem of such applications. Filing fee and rental have been paid.
