

20. (APPLICATION FOR ROAD EASEMENT, CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U. S. ARMY, SACRAMENTO DISTRICT - W.O. 1223, P.R.C. 710.) The Corps of Engineers, U. S. Army, Sacramento District, has made application to the State Lands Commission for a road easement, containing 5.68 acres, more or less, being Tract 211 of the Folsom Dam and Reservoir Project, located in the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T. 11 N., R. 8 E., M.D.M., El Dorado County, for which they offer to pay to the State \$100.

On April 28, 1950 (Minute Item 7, Pages 1112-1113), the Commission approved the sale of the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ and other land to Edmond C. Easton, the single bidder, at a price of \$4 per acre. Patent was issued June 15, 1950, reserving to the State of California an easement through the $W\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 36 for a roadway, power lines, telephone lines and allied purposes 60 feet in width lying 30 feet on each side of the centerline thereof as hereinafter constructed, including the right to extend the slopes of the road to locations outside of the exterior limits of the said 60-foot easement for the purpose of the construction and maintenance of the cuts and fills required for road for servicing Folsom Dam, a Corps of Engineers' project.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A ROAD EASEMENT FOR 5.68 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, BEING TRACT 211 OF THE FOLSON DAM AND RESERVOIR PROJECT, LOCATED IN THE $W\frac{1}{2}$ OF THE $NW\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 36, T. 11 N., R. 8 E., M.D.M., EL DORADO COUNTY, TO THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS, U. S. ARMY, FOR A CONSIDERATION OF \$100 TO BE DEPOSITED IN THE SCHOOL LAND FUND, SAID EASEMENT TO BE ISSUED FOR A PERIOD NOT TO EXCEED 49 YEARS.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
