merits of the movie about the tidelands question, entitled "Freedom's Shores", which has been produced on behalf of the Harbor Commission of the City of Long Beach. Messrs. Watson and Hortig reported that they had seen the picture, and felt that it could possibly serve a worthwhile purpose in the State's fight on this problem.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, A RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO PURCHASE FIVE PRINTS OF THE MOVIE "FREEDOM'S SHORES", AND TO MAKE THEM AVAILABLE TO STATE SENATOR ARTHUR H. BREED, JR., THE COST OF SAME TO BE PAID FROM THE ALLOTMENT FOR THE DEFENSE OF THE TIDELANDS.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.
