30. (SAIARY ADJUSTMENT, EXEMPT POSITIONS - PERSONNEL.) Under date of October 19, 1953, the Executive Officer was advised by James S. Dean, Director of Finance, that salary ranges for exempt positions were revised by the Department of Finance, effective October 1, 1953, under the provisions of Section 18004, Government Code. The revisions included Executive Officer, State Lands Commission, from range \$745 - \$905 to \$782 - \$950. The letter stated that any increases to be effected must be approved by the legally designated salary fixing authority (appointing power).

The Commission was informed that the State Personnel Board adjusted the salaries of nearly all classes of Civil Service employees as of July 1 and October 1, 1953, including those classes immediately below that of Executive Officer, Division of State Lands, thus affecting internal salary relationships.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, IT WAS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

The salary of the Executive Officer, State Lands Commission, is revised, effective October 1, 1953, from salary step \$905 to \$950.
