4. (SUBMARINE CEOFHYSICAL EXPLORATION, VENTURA, LOJ ANGELES, ORANGE, SAN DIEGO COUNTIES, RICHFIELD OIL CORPORATION - W.O. 2887, P.R.C. 1433.1.) Richfield Oil Corporation has made application for authorization to conduct submarine geophysical exploration operations on those tide and submerged lands under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission lying between the northerly boundary of the County of Vantura and the California-Mexico Border. An operating permit has been requested for the period October 1, 1954 to December 31, 1954, inclusive. The Boards of Supervisors of the counties of Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego were informed that this application was to be considered. The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

The Standard Oil Company of California has made application for extension of the term of submarine geophysical exploration permits P.R.C. 962.1(A), 962.1(B), 962.1(C), 963.1(A) and 963.1(B), authorized for operation in the offshore areas of Los Angeles, Ventura, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo Counties to permit initiation and completion of the exploration program for which these permits were requested originally.
