- (4) Capitan (Santa Barbara County). Tide and submerged land area subject to threat of drainage from wells planned for upland development.
- (5) Guadalupe (San Luis Obispo County). Tide and submerged land area currently being drained to a limited extent by existing onshore wells.

"A pre-planned program for the review of all elements entering into leasing of these areas may be more directly to the point than an over-all survey of the coast, which coatains many areas of no particular significance.

"With this in mind it is recommended that a special item of \$50,000 be included in the 1955-56 Budget to accomplish the purpose. The scope of the investigations will be patterned after the one currently proposed for the south Huntington Beach area, with such modifications as experience there will dictate."

After full discussion it was decided to defer action on this matter pending review of the suggested program by the consulting board.

There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned.

Note: Lieutenant Governor Powers, having been unable to attend, was conferred with in respect to the foregoing actions on April 14, 1955. He concurred with the action taken.
