Mr. Kirkwood pointed out the importance to the State of both Calendar Items Nos. 3 and 4, and indicated that he thought industry should be asked to help the State with what is really a "rough spot".

Assemblyman Allen Miller reported that several members of his committee have indicated their intention to submit legislation on oil and gas problems, and stated that before the Legislature convenes he and his committee would appreciate an opportunity to meet with the Commission and with the staff on the proposed oil and gas legislation.

Mr. Robert T. Patton, Chairman of the Public Lands Committee of the Western Oil and Gas Association, indicated that his committee would be willing at any time to meet with the Commission or the staff.
