

MINUTE ITEM

11. (APPLICATION TO DREDGE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, VICINITY OF WHARF AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SHELL OIL COMPANY - P.R.C. 543.1, W. O. 2769.)

After presentation of Calendar Item 35 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE ACTING EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE SHELL OIL COMPANY A PERMIT TO DREDGE THE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS ADJOINING THE WHARF AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, UNDER LEASE P.R.C. 543.1, CONTINGENT UPON THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT FROM THE U. S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS FOR SUCH DREDGING IN IMPROVEMENT OF NAVIGATION. ~~THE PERMIT SHALL LIMIT THE DREDGING TO A MAXIMUM OF 350,000 CUBIC YARDS. THE CONSIDERATION FOR THE PERMIT IS TO BE THE BENEFIT TO NAVIGATION.~~

(APPLICATION TO DREDGE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, VICINITY OF WHARF AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SHELL OIL COMPANY - P.R.C. 543.1.)

An application has been received from Shell Oil Company for a permit to ~~dredge the tide and submerged lands of the State, adjoining a wharf at~~ Martinez, to improve the docking facilities. The lands are held by Shell Oil Company under State Lease P.R.C. 543.1. Section 6303, Public Resources Code, provides in part:

"When a contractor or permittee has a contract with or a permit from the Federal Government or any authorized public agency to dredge navigable streams for the improvement of navigation, the commission may, when in the best interests of the State, allow such contractor or permittee to have sand, gravel, or other spoils dredged from the sovereign lands of the State located within the areas specified in such contract or permit without paying a royalty therefor. The amounts of sand, gravel or other spoils so removed from sovereign lands shall not exceed those specified in the contract or permit."

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE ACTING EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE THE SHELL OIL COMPANY A PERMIT TO DREDGE THE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS ADJOINING THE WHARF AT MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, UNDER LEASE P.R.C. 543.1, CONTINGENT UPON THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT FROM THE U.
