(RECOMMENDATIONS ON STATE INDEMNITY SELECTION AND LAND EXCHANGE APPLICATIONS, RAYMOND R. KAHL - W. O. 2730.)

On September 13, 1957 Mr. Raymond R. Kahl presented to the Commission on behalf of the Trails End Development Company his recommendations on the matter of acceptance of State indemnity selection applications or land exchange applications in lieu of the currently available alternative procedure for the purchase of vacant State school land and subsequent consumption of private land exchanges. Pursuant to the direction of the Commission, the written presentation of Mr. Kahl was referred to the office of the Attorney General for review and report as to any bases for further consideration or action by the Commission.

After review of the presentation by Mr. Kahl, the office of the Attorney General has concluded that in view of the suspensions established by the Commission with respect to lieu land and exchange applications, the only possibility for further consideration and action would be dependent upon the existence of a valid exchange application by Mr. Kahl filed prior to the time of the suspension orders. No application has been filed by Mr. Kahl in accordance with the established Rules and Regulations for action either under the lieu land or exchange procedures. Therefore it has been concluded that there are no bases for further consideration or action by the Commission on the presentation by Mr. Kahl.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ACTING EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO INFORM MR. RAYMOND R. KAHL OF THE CONCLUSION OF THE COMMISSION IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE INFORMAL OPINION OF THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL THAT THERE ARE NO FURTHER BASES FOR CONSIDERATION OR ACTION BY THE COMMISSION ON THE PRESENTATION SUBMITTED BY MR. KAHL SEPTEMBER 13, 1957.
