

MINUTE ITEM

11. SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 10773-M, LOS ANGELES LAND DISTRICT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, GEORGE McCARTHY - S.W.O. 5804.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT IT IS TO THE ADVANTAGE OF THE STATE TO SELECT THE FEDERAL LAND EMBRACED IN THE S $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 28 AND E $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 29, T. 4 N., R. 4 E., S.B.M., CONTAINING A TOTAL OF 640 ACRES IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY;
2. APPROVES THE SELECTION OF SAID LAND.

SELECTION OF VACANT FEDERAL LAND, LIEU LAND APPLICATION NO. 10773-M, LOS ANGELES LAND DISTRICT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, GEORGE MCCARTHY - S.W.O. 5804.

An offer was received from George McCarthy of Apple Valley, California, to purchase the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 28 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 29, T. 4 N., R. 4. E., S.B.M., containing a total of 640 acres in San Bernardino County, for \$3,200, or \$5 per acre. This land may be obtained by the State from the Federal Government under the indemnity selection procedure.

The applicant did not desire to proceed with acquisition of the land, and his application was canceled at his request.

The selection of the subject land is considered to be to the advantage of the State in that it will assist the State in satisfying deficiencies under the School Land Grant.

The State's application to select the land has been accepted by the Bureau of Land Management and the land was listed (conveyed) to the State on June 21, 1960.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT IT IS TO THE ADVANTAGE OF THE STATE TO SELECT THE FEDERAL LAND EMBRACED IN THE S $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 28 AND E $\frac{1}{2}$ OF SECTION 29, T. 4 N., R. 4 E., S.B.M., CONTAINING A TOTAL OF 640 ACRES IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY;
