

MINUTE ITEM

4. APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR TIDE-RECORDING STATION IN SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; CITY OF STOCKTON - W.O. 4083, P.R.C. 2861.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF STOCKTON A 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN A TIDE-RECORDING GAUGE ON A PORTION OF SUBMERGED LAND DESCRIBED AS:

A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND 10 FEET IN WIDTH IN THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, THE CENTERLINE BEING DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE ON THE RIGHT BANK OF THE SAN JOAQUIN RIVER WHICH BEARS WEST, 3,317.41 FEET AND S. 8° 07' W., 700 FEET MORE OR LESS FROM THE INTERSECTION OF THE CENTERLINES OF KERN STREET AND CHARTER WAY IN STOCKTON, CALIFORNIA, THENCE FROM SAID POINT OF BEGINNING S. 28° 44' 30" W., 75 FEET, CONTAINING 0.017 ACRE MORE OR LESS.

THE CONSIDERATION FOR ISSUANCE OF THE PERMIT IS TO BE THE PUBLIC BENEFIT.

APPLICATION FOR 49-YEAR LIFE-OF-STRUCTURE PERMIT FOR TIDE-RECORDING STATION IN SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY; CITY OF STOCKTON - W.O. 4083.

The City of Stockton has applied for a permit to construct and maintain a tide-recording gauge on submerged lands in the San Joaquin River. The gauge will be located on the north bank of the San Joaquin River just south of the City of Stockton's sewage treatment plant.

The consideration for issuance of the permit is to be the public benefit.
