APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF ASSIGNMENT FROM NEVADA NATURAL GAS PIPE LINE COMPANY TO SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION, OF RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT P.R.C. 905.1, COLORADO RIVER, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY - W.O. 4385.

Right-of-Way Easement P.R.C. 905.1, covering submerged lands of the Coloredo River about two miles north of the City of Needles, was issued to Nevada Natural Gas Pipe Line Company for a term of 49 years, the land being used for the maintenance and operation of a suspension bridge to carry a high-pressure gas pipe line.

Nevada Natural Gas Pipe Line Company and Southwest Gas Corporation were combined, effective March 23, 1962, through a statutory merger under the laws of the States of California and Nevada, with the Southwest Gas Corporation as the survivor.

The Southwest Gas Corporation has applied to this Division for approval of the assignment to it of Easement P.R.C. 905.1, and has lorwarded three executed copies of the assignment. In conformance with Paragraph 13 of the easement there is a \$5,000 continuing bond presently in effect, on which Southwest Gas Corporation has agreed to become a principal. The \$5 statutory filing fee has been paid.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE ASSIGNMENT FROM NEVADA NATURAL GAS PIPE LINE COMPANY TO SOUTHWEST GAS CORPORATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY EASEMENT P.R.C. 905.1, COVERING A GAS PIPELINE CROSSING THE COLORADO RIVER NORTH OF NEEDLES IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY.
