Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company has applied for the approval of the location of a proposed telephone cable over 0.50 acre more or less of tide and submerged lands of Hudeman Slough near the United States Navy bridge to Skaggs Island, Sonoma County (see Exhibit "A").

This cable is to provide telephone and telegraph service and facilities to Skaggs Island. The United States Navy, which is operator of the bridge next to the proposed cable, has given its written permission to Pacific Telephone and Telegraph to install the proposed cable at this site.

In accordance with Section 7901 of the Public Utilities Code and with Attorney General's Opinion No. 52/56, the Commission previously adopted the "approval-of-location agreement forms" to be used for telephone and telegraph facilities crossing State lands.
