PUBLIC HEARING RE CHAPTER 1885, STATUTES OF 1959; CLARIFICATION OF TITLE; ALAMEDA, SAN MATEO AND SANTA CLARA COUNTIES; LESLIE SALT CO. - W.O. 1339.

Pursuant to Chapter 1885, Statutes of 1959, and formal action by the State Lands Commission at its meeting of December 17, 1964, a public hearing was held relative to the proposed clarification of title between the State of California and Leslie Salt over certain lands in San Francisco Bay. The hearing was held on Thursday, January 14, 1965, at 10:00 a.m. in the Assembly Room of the California State Building in Oakland.

Interest in the proposed transaction was high, with a good cross-section of representatives of public and private interests in attendance, many of them desiring to present testimony. Such testimony, both oral and written, was received. Additionally, new data was received that will warrant further study and inquiry by the staff.

The Commission's staff is now preparing an analysis, and a report, including recommendations as to further considerations by the Commission.
