

MINUTE ITEM

21. APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF LOCATION OF DRILLING AND PRODUCTION PLATFORM  
HOPE, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - P.R.C. 315C.1.

During consideration of Calendar Item 7 attached, the Executive Officer noted for the record that the original location for the offshore platform was found to be legally satisfactory by the Office of the Attorney General and satisfactory by the Department of Parks and Recreation as to any impingement on recreational interests. The new location is going to be 300 feet farther out to sea, and therefore should be satisfactory, but will be reviewed with both the Attorney General's Office and with Beaches and Parks before any construction is permitted to be undertaken.

UPON MOTION DULY MADE AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE LOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION BY STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A PYLON-SUPPORTED "OUTRIGGER TYPE" DRILLING AND PRODUCTION PLATFORM AT A NEW LOCATION APPROXIMATELY 17,700 FEET FROM SHORE AND SOUTH OF SAND POINT WITHIN THE LEASED AREA OF OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 315C.1, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT THE LESSEE FURNISH A GOOD AND SUFFICIENT BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000 TO GUARANTEE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE BY THE LESSEE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PLATFORM AND THE REMOVAL THEREOF AT THE REQUEST OF THE STATE UPON THE EXPIRATION OR SOONER TERMINATION OF THE LEASE, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 14 OF OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3150.1.

APPLICATION FOR CHANGE OF LOCATION OF DRILLING AND PRODUCTION PLATFORM HOPE, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - P.R.C. 3150.1.

An application has been received from the Standard Oil Company of California, joint lessee and operator under State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3150.1, requesting approval of the change of location of a stationary "outrigger type" pylon-supported drilling and production platform to a new location 300 feet further from shore and 735 feet westerly from the location approved by the Commission on September 24, 1964 (Minute Item 19, page 10,474). The new location is 17,700 feet from shore, in the vicinity of Carpinteria, within the leased area (see Exhibits "A" and "B").

The Corps of Engineers has issued a Department of the Army permit authorizing the construction and maintenance of the drilling and production platform at the newly specified location.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE THE LOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION BY STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A PYLON-SUPPORTED "OUTRIGGER TYPE" DRILLING AND PRODUCTION PLATFORM AT A NEW LOCATION APPROXIMATELY 17,700 FEET FROM SHORE AND SOUTH OF SAND POINT WITHIN THE LEASED AREA OF OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3150.1, SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION THAT THE LESSEE FURNISH A GOOD AND SUFFICIENT BOND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000 TO GUARANTEE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE BY THE LESSEE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PLATFORM AND THE REMOVAL THEREOF AT THE REQUEST OF THE STATE UPON THE EXPIRATION OR SOONER TERMINATION OF THE LEASE, AS REQUIRED BY SECTION 14 OF OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3150.1.
