

MINUTE ITEM

22. APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO CONDUCT SUBMARINE GEOPHYSICAL OPERATIONS; SANTA BARBARA, VENTURA, LOS ANGELES, ORANGE, AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC. - W.O. 5604, P.R.C. 3274.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 22 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE PERMITIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 29, 1965, THROUGH JULY 28, 1965, COVERING THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION WHICH ARE SEAWARD OF THE "OPERATIONS LINE" APPROVED DECEMBER 6, 1962 (MINUTE ITEM 29, PAGE 8485), IN THE AREA:

- A. LYING BETWEEN A LINE DRAWN DUE WEST FROM POINT CONCEPTION, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF $X = 1,441,189.36$ FEET AND $Y = 335,615.67$ FEET.
- B. LYING BETWEEN THE SEAWARD EXTENSION OF A LINE DRAWN DUE SOUTH FROM A POINT ON THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL HAVING ZONE 5 CALIFORNIA COORDINATES OF $X = 1,515,471.78$ FEET AND $Y = 338,667.70$ FEET, AND A LINE FORMING THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF EMERY BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF.
- C. LYING BETWEEN THE EASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL A ABOVE AND THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE SANTA BARBARA CHANNEL.
- D. LYING BETWEEN A LINE FORMING THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF ORANGE COUNTY AND THE SEAWARD EXTENSION THEREOF, AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.
- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE AND THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.

THE PERMIT SHALL CONFORM TO ALL OPERATING CONDITIONS ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION. THE PERMITTEE IS TO REIMBURSE THE STATE LANDS DIVISION FOR ALL OF ITS INSPECTION COSTS. THE PERMIT IS TO BE EFFECTIVE ONLY AS LONG AS A CONCURRENT PERMIT BY THE FISH AND GAME COMMISSION IS IN EFFECT FOR THE SAME OPERATING AREA.

An application has been received from Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc., for a permit to conduct geophysical exploration operations for a period of three months on tide and submerged lands in the area lying between a line drawn due West from Point Conception, Santa Barbara County, and the south boundary of San Diego County.

The Boards of Supervisors of the Counties of Santa Barbara, Ventura, Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego, and the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Santa Barbara have been informed that this application is to be considered.

The statutory filing fee has been paid by the applicant.

Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc., also has submitted an application to the Department of Fish and Game for the conduct of seismic operations covering the area in which it is proposed to conduct operations.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE A GEOPHYSICAL EXPLORATION PERMIT TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 29, 1965, THROUGH JULY 28, 1965, COVERING THOSE TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION WHICH ARE SHOREWARD OF THE "OPERATIONS LINE" APPROVED DECEMBER 6, 1962 (MINUTE ITEM 29, PAGE 8485), IN THE AREA:

- E. LYING BETWEEN THE SOUTHEASTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL B ABOVE AND THE NORTHWESTERLY BOUNDARY OF PARCEL D ABOVE, AND BEING ALSO SEAWARD OF A LINE LOCATED THREE NAUTICAL MILES SEAWARD FROM THE MEAN HIGH TIDE LINE OF THE GULF OF SANTA CATALINA.

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
