10. APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY,
LYLE V. PLATT - W.O. 5408, P.R.C. 3337.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 20 attached, and upon motion duly made
and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO LYLE V. PLATT TO
DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 1200 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO
RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, AT A ROYALTY OF \$0.09 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL MATERIAL
REMOVED FROM STATE LANDS. THE AREA TO BE INCLUDED IN THE PERMIT IS DESCRIBED
IN EXHIBIT "A".

APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT, SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY; LYLE V. PLATT - W.O. 5408.

An application has been received from Lyle V. Platt for a permit to dredge approximately 1200 cubic yards of material from an area of State-owned lands in the bed of the Sacramento River, located adjacent to Lot A of the Natomas-Elkhorn Subdivision, approximately three miles above the Elkhorn Ferry in Sacramento County. The material is to be used as fill material on upland property owned by the applicant.

Section 6303 of the Public Resources Code provides that when a permittee has a contract with or a permit from the Federal government or any authorized public agency to dredge beds of navigable streams for the improvement of navigation, reclamation, or flood control, the Commission may, when in the best interests of the State, allow such permittee to have sand, gravel, or other spoils dredged from the sovereign lands of the State located within the areas specified in such contract or permit upon such terms and conditions and for such consideration as will be in the best interests of the State.

The U. S. Corps of Engineers has issued a Department of the Army permit authorizing the conduct of dredging operations at the location described in the application. The Division of Beaches and Parks has reported that the proposed operation would not interfere with any of its programs in the area.

The Department of Fish and Game has submitted a letter of nonobjection to the operation.

The \$5 filing fee has been submitted by the applicant.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ISSUE A PERMIT TO LYLE V. PLATT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 1200 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, AT A ROYALTY OF \$0.02 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL MATERIAL REMOVED FROM STATE LANDS. THE AREA TO BE INCLUDED IN THE PERMIT IS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A".

EXHIBIT "A"

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the Sacramento River, County of Sacramento, State of California, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the northwesterly line of the 30-foot "private road and canal right of way", being located within the "River Levee Right of Way, Reclamation District No. 1000", as shown on map No. 42, according to the official plat thereof, filed in the office of the Recorder, Sacramento County, California, on February 26, 1918 in Book 15 of Maps, and from which point the most easterly corner of Lot 144 bears North $37^{\circ} 44'$ E. 105.74 feet and along a curve to the right having a radius of 2,814.93 feet, the chord of which bears N. $39^{\circ} 18'$ E. 154.00 feet and continuing along said curve to the right, the chord of which bears N. $43^{\circ} 03'$ E. 214.40 feet and thence N. $45^{\circ} 14'$ E. 50.01 feet to a point on the northeasterly line of said Lot 144 and S. $42^{\circ} 30'$ E. 2,338.42 feet distant; thence from said point of commencement following the northwesterly line of said right-of-way S. $37^{\circ} 44'$ W. 210.00 feet; thence N. $52^{\circ} 16'$ W. 182.80 feet more or less to the Mean High Tide Line of the east bank of the Sacramento River, which is the true point of beginning of this description; thence leaving the Mean High Tide Line N. $50^{\circ} 38' 50''$ W. 200.00 feet, N. $39^{\circ} 21' 10''$ E. 218.69 feet; thence S. $48^{\circ} 12' 40''$ E. 201.00 feet to the aforementioned Mean High Tide Line; thence proceeding along same S. $41^{\circ} 47' 20''$ W. 19.38 feet and S. $39^{\circ} 21' 10''$ W. 190.79 feet to the point of beginning; containing 0.98 acre more or less.
