36. APPLICATION TO LEASE TWO CONTIGUOUS PARCELS OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN PABLO BAY, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SEQUOLA REFINING CORPORATION - W.O. 5459, P.R.C. 3414.1.

After consideration of Supplemental Calendar Item 34 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO ISSUE TO SEQUOLA REFINING CORPORATION A 15-YEAR LEASE COVERING TWO PARCELS OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN PABLO BAY, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1. A \$50,000 PERFORMANCE BOND SHALL BE PROVIDED ON A CONTINUING BASIS;
- 2. THE LESSEE SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO RENEW THE LEASE FOR 3 ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF 10 YEARS EACH, SUBJECT TO SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE STATE MAY IMPOSE AT THE TIME OF EACH RENEWAL;
- 3. THE UNADJUSTED ANNUAL RENTAL SHALL COTNINUE AT THE RATE OF \$10,000 UNTIL A FIRM RENTAL IS ESTABLISHED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT;
- 4. WHEN A FIRM RENTAL IS ESTABLISHED, THERE SHALL BE A RETROACTIVE ADJUST-MENT TO THE END THAT THE TOTAL OF ALL RENTALS THERETOFORE ACCRUED UNDER THE LEASE SHALL EQUAL THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD HAVE ACCRUED HAD THE FIRM RENTAL BEEN IN EFFECT SINCE NOVEMBER 18, 1965;
- 5. IN THE EVENT LESSEE RECUSES TO ACCEPT WITHIN SIXTY DAYS A FINAL OFFER BY THE STATE WHICH WOULD ESTABLISH A FIRM RESTAL, THE LEASE SHALL TERMINATE AND THE LESSEE SHALL PAY THE STATE THE FAIR RENTAL VALUE AS ESTABLISHED BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION TO THE DATE OF TERMINATION;
- 6. THE DESCRIPTION AND AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS COVERED BY THE LEASE IS AS FOLLOWS:

APPLICATION TO LEASE TWO CONTIGUOUS PARCELS OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN PABLO BAY, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; SEQUOIA REFINING CORPORATION - W.O. 5459.

The Sequoia Refining Corporation has requested a lease of two contiguous parcels of tide and submerged land for the accommodation of pipelines and a deep water pier located 0.86 mile northwest of Lone Tree Point in San Fablo Bay near Carquiaez Straits, as shown on Exhibit "A".

Parcel 1, comprising 8.366 acres, covers a 50' x 7288' strip running from an onshore point waterward to a pier site, Parcel 2. This strip will carry eight pipelines which will be buried at a minimum depth of five feet below the existing bay bottom. There will be one 20-inch crude oil pipeline, two 8-inch product pipelines, and five other service lines having a diameter of four inches or less for water, power, telephone cables, etc.

Parcel 2, comprising 11.938 acres and located at the waterward terminus of the easement strip, will be improved by 247' x 900' pier and related dolphins which will initially accommodate tankers of 45,000 d.w.t. However, the pier is designed to berth tankers of 100,000 d.w.t. when a project by the U.S. Department of the Army, Corps of Engineers, for deepening the channel to 45 feet is completed.

The proposed pier and submarine pipe ines, which are appurtenant to a new refinery, will cost an estimated \$1,450,000.

The initial lease period will be 15 years with provision for three 10-year renewal options, subject to such terms and conditions as the State might impose at the time of each renewal.

A performance bond in the amount of \$50,000 will be required.

The proposed construction has been approved by the San Francisco Bay Conservation & Development Commission. A navigational permit will be issued by the U. S. Department of the A.my, Corps of Engineers.

The unadjusted annual rental for & 15-year lease will be \$10,000, payable in advance.

The proposed land utilization is of the same type as that involved currently in valuation problems with other oil companies. Therefore, the lease will provide for a retroactive adjustment upon renegotiation of the rental terms resulting from resolution of the valuation problems.

IT IS PECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFF LER TO ISSUE TO SECUOIA REFLICING CORPORATION A 15-YEAR LEASE COVERING TWO PARCELS OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN PABLO BAY, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. A \$50,000 HERFORMANCE BOND SHALL BE PROVIDED ON A CONTINUING BASIS;

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- 2. THE LESSEE SHALL HAVE THE RIGHT TO RENEW THE LEASE FOR 3 ADDITIONAL FERIODS OF 10 YEARS EACH, SUBJECT TO SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE STATE MAY IMPOSE AT THE TIME OF EACH RENEWAL.
- 3. THE UNADJUSTED ANNUAL RENTAL SHALL CONTINUE AT THE RATE OF \$10,000 UNTIL A FIRM RENTAL IS ESTABLISHED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENT;
- 4. WHEN A FIRM RENTAL IS ESTABLISHED, THERE SHALL BE A RETROACTIVE ADJUST-MENT TO THE END THAT THE TOTAL OF ALL RENTALS THERETOFORE ACCRUED UNDER THE LEASE SHALL EQUAL THE AMOUNT THAT WOULD HAVE ACCRUED HAD THE FIRM RENTAL BEEN IN EFFECT SINCE NOVEMBER 18, 1965;
