WITHDRAWAL OF PROSPECTING PERMIT, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; UNITED STATES BORAX AND CHEMICAL COMPANY - W.O. 5452, P.R.C. 3359.2.

The United States Borax and Chemical Company, by application dated December 10, 1964, requested a permit to prospect for all minerals other than oil and gas on Section 16, T. 8 N., R. 5 E., S.B.B.& M., San Bernardino County.

On August 26, 1965 (Minute Item 22, page 11,612), pursuant to Section 6891 of the Public Resources Code, the Commission authorized the Executive Officer to issue to United States Borax and Chemical Company a two-year permit to prospect for all minerals other than oil and gas on 640 acres more or less in which all minerals are reserved to the State in the aforementioned Section 16. The applicant, by letter dated December 20, 1965, withdrew its application to prospect Section 16.
