On June 4, 1965, an offer was received from the State Department of Public Works, Division of Highways, to purchase Tract 37, T. 17 S., R. 9 E., S.B.M., containing 640 acres more or less in Imperial County, at \$35 per acre.

THE PROPERTY

Location: On the east slope of the Jacumba Mountains, 33 miles west of

El Centro and 85 miles east of San Diego.

Access: None at present to any part of the section from the freeway

(formerly U.S. Highway 80, granted by easement issued February 29, 1940, pursuant to Chapter 672, Stats. 1931), which crosses over a portion of the north half. However, the appraised value assumes the pre-freeway condition, i.e., access to the remainder of the section outside of the right-

of-way as it existed with U.S. Highway 80.

Water: None

Terrain: Mountainous, rocky, steep to very steep slope.

Elevation: 1,800' to 2,500'.
