144. SERVICE AGREEMENT, CHAPTER 1737, STATUTES OF 1965; PERALTA JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT, COUNTY OF ALAMEDA - W.O. 5846, GEO.-ALAMEDA CO., P & C.

After consideration of Calendar Item 14 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER IS AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE PERALTA JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT, COUNTY OF ALAMEDA, CALIFORNIA, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AS CONTRACTOR, PROVIDING FOR SURVEYING, MONUMENTING, AND PLATFING SERVICES TO BE RENDERED THE DISTRICT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1737/65, THE PAYMENT TO THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR SAID SERVICES TO BE THE COMMISSION'S ACTUAL COSTS NOT TO EXCEED \$500.

SERVICE AGREEMENT, CHAPTER 1737, STATUTES OF 1965; FERALTA JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT, COUNTY OF ALAMEDA - W.O. 5846.

Section 6359 of the Public Resources Code provides that the State Lands Commission shall survey, monument, and record a plat of any tide and submerged lands granted by the Legislature.

Chapter 1737/65 conveys certain described tide and submerged lands to the Peralta Junior College District, County of Alameda; accordingly, the State Lands Commission is required, at the cost of the grantee, to survey, monument, plat, and record a plat of the granted lands.

The work is to be performed on a contract basis, and an agreement has been drawn by the Peralta Junior College District that provides for the rendering of the services by the State Lands Division at its estimated cost of not to exceed \$500.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE A SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE PERALTA JUNIOR COLLEGE DISTRICT, COUNTY OF ALAMEDA, CALIFOR-NIA, ON BEHLAF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AS CONTRACTOR, PROVIDING FOR SURVEYING, MONUMENTING, AND PLATTING SERVICES TO BE RENDERED THE DISTRICT FUR-SUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 1737/65, THE PAYMENT TO THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION FOR SAID SERVICES TO BE THE COMMISSION'S ACTUAL COSTS NOT TO EXCEED \$500.
