EXHIBIT "A"

A circular parcel of submerged land 10 feet in diameter situated in Lake Tahoe southeasterly of Tahoma, California, being located in Placer County approximately 100 feet North of the Placer-El Dorado County line; the center point of sail circular parcel being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in Lake Tahoe from which a 1-inch iron pipe with cap stamped "L.S. 2217 S8/S17" as shown on "Survey of the low water mark on the shore of Lake Tahoe vicinity of Tahoma" prepared by the State Lands Division and recorded May 6, 1965, Book 2, page 12, Document 7367 Official Records of Placer County bears S. 83° 00' W. 970 feet, and also from which the "Tehoe Cedars Tract pier" bears westerly 75 feet; said POINT OF BEGINNING being the center point of said eigenvalue parcel.

Containing 78.54 square feet.
