DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS

P.R.C.: 2991.1
LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California
COUNTY: Santa Barbara
AREA: Offshore Capitan Beach State Park
ISSUED: February 28, 1963
WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Three wells drilled, and abandoned.
PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From March 14, 1966, through September 13, 1967
THIS DEFERMENT: From September 14, 1967, through March 13, 1968
REASON FOR REQUEST: To conduct evaluation of data obtained from a well currently drilling approximately two miles from the boundary of the lease and from seismic work done on the lease in November 1966.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO GRANT TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2991.1 THROUGH MARCH 13, 1968, ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
