12. RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT, LAKE TADOE, PLACER COUNTY; ARBUTUS YOUTH ASSOCIATION, INC. - W.O. 6411, P.R.C. 3823.1.

RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT

APPLICANT: Arbutus Youth Association, Inc.

LOCATION: Submerged land in Lake Tahoe at Takoma, Placer County

PROPOSED USE: The bottoming of two buoys for mooring small boats

TERM: 5 years

CONSIDERATION: \$50 total for term

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$25 total fee for 1-5 years for each buoy site

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

U. S. Army Corps of Engineers navigational permit issued

EXHIBIT "A"

Two circular parcels of submerged land 10 feet in diameter in Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California, situate northerly of Meeks Bay; the center points being described as follows:

Parcel 1

A point 50 feet northerly of the common boundary between Placer and El Dorado Counties and 200 feet easterly of the shore line of Lake Tahoe.

Parcel 2

A point 280 feet northerly of the common boundary between Placer and El Dorado Counties and 550 feet easterly of the shore line of Lake Tahoe.

The two parcels comprising 0.0036 acre.
