28. DREDGING PERMIT, Noyo HARBOR DISTRICT, SUBMERGED LANDS, NOYO RIVER,
MENDOCINO COUNTY - W.O. 6504.

During consideration of Calendar Item 48 attached, Mr. E. A. Curtis, Chief
of the Development Branch of the State Department of Harbors and Watercraft,
requested that no charge be made for the 10,000 cubic yards of material to
be dredged, inasmuch as it is to be on government land.

Action was deferred until the October 1967 meeting of the Commission.

DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Noyo Harbor District

LOCATION: Submerged lands, Noyo River, Mendocino County

PURPOSE: To construct a mooring basin about 0.7 mile upstream from the mouth of the Noyo River

AMOUNT TO BE DREDGED: 10,000 cubic yards

DISPOSITION OF DREDGED MATERIAL: Approximately 10,000 cubic yards of silty fine sand to be disposed of on adjacent property (see Exhibit "A") owned by the Noyo Harbor District

CONSIDERATION: Royalty of \$0.03 per cubic yard

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: See purpose and disposition

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE NOYO HARBOR DISTRICT TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 10,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, AT A ROYALTY OF \$0.03 PER CUBIC YARD FOR MATERIAL REMOVED, FROM AN AREA OF GRANTED SUBMERGED LANDS WITHIN THE BED OF THE NOYO RIVER DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

THAT PORTION OF THOSE LANDS PREVIOUSLY OWNED BY THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND CONVEYED BY LEGISLATIVE GRANT IN CHAPTER 555, STATS. 1961, TO THE NOYO HARBOR DISTRICT, SAID CONVEYANCE BEING DELINEATED ON SHEETS 3 AND 4 OF 9, OF A PLAT OF A "SURVEY OF THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK ON THE BANKS OF THE NOYO RIVER - VICINITY OF FORT BRAGG-MENDOCINO COUNTY, CALIFORNIA" FILED IN MAP CASE 1, DRAWER 10 AT PAGE 42, SERIES 12596, RECORDS OF MENDOCINO COUNTY, PREPARED BY THE CALIFORNIA STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BEING CERTIFIED ON AUGUST 3, 1955, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING AT STATION "S46" AS SHOWN ON SHEET 3 OF 9 OF SAID STATE LANDS COMMISSION MAPS; THENCE N. 29° 58' 35" E., 368.26 FEET; THENCE N. 10° 37' 21" E., 32.56 FEET; THENCE N. 52° 54' 26" E., 154.20 FEET; THENCE N. 49° 49' 15" E., 117.80 FEET; THENCE N. 56° 00' 13" E., 103.74 FEET; THENCE N. 41° 38' 01" E., 24.08 FEET; THENCE N. 53° 14' 33" E., 305.80 FEET; THENCE N. 48° 57' 53" E., 77.68 FEET TO A POINT IN THE LINE BETWEEN STATIONS "S53" AND "S54;" THENCE WEST, 19.10 FEET; THENCE S. 64° 43' 20" W., 139.34 FEET; THENCE S. 52° 16' 39" W., 431.49 FEET; THENCE S. 43° 08' 17" W., 235.03 FEET; THENCE S. 28° 50' 49" W., 200.00 FEET; THENCE N. 60° 01' 25" E., 87.29 FEET TO A POINT IN THE NORTH SIDE OF THE NOYO RIVER; THENCE S. 30° 57' 50" W., 150.00 FEET; THENCE S. 58° 09' 32" W., 220.00 FEET TO THE EASTERN LIMIT OF PRESENTLY MAINTAINED RIVER CHANNEL; THENCE S. 16° 18' 26" E., 110.00 FEET; THENCE N. 55° 17' 17" E., 275.56 FEET; THENCE S. 60° 01' 25" E., 20.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING, CONTAINING 1.749 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
