Texaco Inc., Humble Oil & Refining Company, Union Oil Company of California, Mobil Oil Corporation, and Shell Oil Company, as Field Contractor for the Long Beach Unit, have requested approval of the conveyance of a production payment to Institute Oil, Inc., and a concurrent hypothecation by Institute Oil, Inc., to Security First National Bank.

Article 25 of the Contractor's Agreement provides, in part, that none of the Contractors shall essign any of its rights under the agreement without first obtaining the written consent of the City Manager, with the approval of the State.

Pursuant to Article 25, the following documents have been submitted for State Lands Commission approval:

- 1. Assignments and Agreements, dated December 29, 1967, between Texaco Inc., Eumble Oil & Esfining Company, Union Oil Company of California, Mobil Oil Corporation, and Shell Oil Company (as Assignor), and Institute Oil, Inc. (as Assignee).
- 2. Security Agreement and Deed of Trust, dated December 29, 1967, from Institute Oil, Inc., to Security First National Bank, as Trustee.
