RECREATIONAL MINOR-STRUCTURE PERMIT

APPLICANT: Roy M. Diedericksen

LOCATION: A 0.023-acre parcel of submerged land in Lake Tahoe in Meeks Bay, El Dorado County

PROPOSED USE: The maintenance of an existing pier

TERM: 5 years, from August 25, 1966

CONSIDERATION: \$25 total for term

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
\$25 total fee for 1-5 years

U.S.A. Corps of Engineers navigational permit issued.
Applicant is owner of upland.

EXHIBIT "A"

Lessee: Roy M. Diedericksen

A parcel of submerged land lying in the bed of Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County, State of California, situate in Section 29, T. 14 N., R. 7 W., M.D.M., and being more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at a point on the low water mark of Lake Tahoe having grid coordinates $X = 2,534,739$, $Y = 501,587$, said point being the point of intersection of the low water line and the northerly line of Lot 35 of "Meeks Bay Vista" subdivision as recorded in the office of the County Recorder of El Dorado County on September 10, 1924; thence along the low water mark south $26^{\circ} 52' 11''$ west 34.00 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of this description; thence leaving the low water mark, and along the following courses:

- 1) South $63^{\circ} 07' 49''$ East 40.00 feet
- 2) South $26^{\circ} 52' 11''$ East 36.00 feet
- 3) North $63^{\circ} 07' 49''$ West 32.00 feet
- 4) North $26^{\circ} 52' 11''$ East 11.00 feet

5) North $63^{\circ} 07' 49''$ West 8.00 feet to a point on the low water line of Lake Tahoe; thence along the low water line North $26^{\circ} 52' 11''$ East to the true point of beginning, and containing .023 acre, more or less.

The basis of bearings of this description is the California Coordinate System, Zone II.
