1. DREDGING PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS, DEL NORTE COUNTY - V.O. 6958, P.R.C. 3924.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE COUNTY OF DEL NORTE TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 1,207,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, ROYALTY OF \$0.01 PER CUBIC YARD FOR ALL MATERIAL REMOVED, FROM AN AREA TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS KNOWN AS TAYLOR ISLAND, ON THE SOUTHERLY BANK OF THE KLAMATH RIVER, DEL NORTE COUNTY, IN THE AREA DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF. THIS PERMIT IS WITHOUT WARRANTY OF TITLE.
