

34. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, P.R.C. 3033.1, HUNTINGTON BEACH OFFSHORE AREA, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 7198.

After consideration of Calendar Item 8 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH JUNE 24, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

P.R.C.: 3033.1

LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California

COUNTY: Orange

AREA: Huntington Beach offshore

ISSUED: July 25, 1963

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Constructed platform "EVA"; drilled thirty-two wells; thirty wells currently producing.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From July 12, 1966, through December 24, 1968

THIS DEFERMENT: December 25, 1968, through June 24, 1969

REASON FOR REQUEST: To evaluate recently completed seismic survey and to correlate the data with information obtained from wells drilled on the lease

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH JUNE 24, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
