38. STIPULATION FOR JUDGMENT IN THE CASE OF THOMAS P. RALEY V. STATE OF CALIFORNIA, YOLO COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT NO. 21087 - W.O. 503. 481.

After consideration of Calendar Item 26 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION FINDS THAT IT IS EXPEDIENT, NECESSARY, AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE TO ENTER INTO THE STIPULATION FOR JUDGMENT WHICH IS ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION IN THE CASE OF THOMAS P. RALEY V. STATE OF CALIFORNIA, YOLO COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT NO. 21087, AND AUTHORIZES THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENTER INTO SUCH STIPULATION AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE SAME.

THOMAS P. RALEY VS. STATE OF CALIFORNIA

The subject action has been pending since 1965 to quiet title to a parcel of land along the Sacramento River across from the City of Sacramento. The Plaintiff claims at successor in interest of a swamp and overflowed lands patentee. The State contends that the land involved was artificially built up and is a part of the former riverbed. Difficult legal and factual questions are involved, and a Stipulation for Judgment has been prepared and is on file in the Office of the State Lands Commission wherein it is agreed that, pursuant to Section 6357 of the Public Resources Code, the line of ordinary high tide is fixed as set forth in the Stipulation. The line designated divides the parcel claimed equally between the Plaintiff and the State. Both the Division and the Office of the Attorney General believe that the allocation of the land set forth in the Stipulation represents a fair and equitable solution of this case and that the same is in the best interests of the State. The Office of the Attorney General recommends approval of the Stipulation.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION FIND THAT IT IS EXPEDIENT, NECESSARY, AND IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE STATE TO ENTER INTO THE STIPULATION FOR JUDG-MENT WHICH IS ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE COMMISSION IN THE CASE OF THOMAS P. RALEY V. STATE OF CALIFORNIA, YCLO COUNTY SUPERIOR CCURT NO. 21087, AND AUTHORIZE THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENTER INTO SUCH STIPULATION AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OF THE COMMISSION TO APPROVE THE SAME.
