# PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT (RIGHT-OF-WAY)

APPLICANT:

Contra Costa County Flood Control and Water Conservation District.

LOCATION:

Approximately 15 acres of tide and submerged land in the natural bed of Pacheco Creek, formerly known as Walnut Creek, easterly of Martinez, Contra Costa County.

LAND USE:

The construction and maintenance of a channel designed to control flooding and to conserve water.

TERM:

49 years, from March 1, 1969.

CONSIDERATION:

- (1) No charge the public protection and benefit.
- (2) A nonmonetary consideration is justified for this permit on the basis of existent policy that, in general, free rights-of-way across State lands for flood-control and water-conservation purposes contribute to the public safety and benefit.

#### PREREQUISITE ITEM:

The District is acquiring property rights, where necessary, in adjacent upland.

### STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Pt. 2, Ch. 1, Secs. 6501-6509.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Secs. 2000-2011.
- c. Commission policy: Minute Item 18 of November 18, 1959.

#### OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- (1) Construction of the channel is being undertaken by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The District is responsible for acquiring necessary property rights and for future operation and maintenance of the channel.
- (2) The matter of a permit to dredge the channel is being handled as a separate item.
- (3) By letter of January 2, 1969, the District reported that the waterway already had been widened and straightened as a trapezoidal earth channel, and that the levees on both sides had been raised. Commencing in July 1969, the levees will be raised again to their ultimate height, and will be gravelled for patrol and maintenance purposes. The work will be completed by August 31, 1969. The District further reports that the entire area of the Creek has been fenced along the right-of-way lines for public safety and District-liability protection.

All that certain tide and submerged land in the bed of Pacheco Creek, formerly known as Wallut Creek, Contra Costa County, lying within the following described parcels:

PARCEL 1: A strip of land 265 feet in width lying 115 feet southeasterly and 150 feet northwesterly of the following described line:

BEGINNING at a point from which State Lands Commission triangulation station "Over" bears S. 55° 14' 09" E. 2374. L feet; thence from said point of beginning S. 49° 25' 14" W. 729.04 feet to point "P-1."

PARCEL 2: A strip of land 240 feet in width lying 115 feet southeasterly and 125 feet northwesterly of the following described line:
