1. FINDS THAT PARCEL NO. 1, THE E $\frac{1}{2}$ OF LOTS 1 AND 2 OF NE $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION 6, T. 9 N., R. 4 E., S.B.M., CONTAINING 79.12 ACRES MORE OR LESS IN SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY, IS NOT SUITABLE FOR CULTIVATION WITHOUT ARTIFICIAL IRRIGATION; AND
2. AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SAID PARCEL, SUBJECT TO ALL STATUTORY AND CONSTITUTIONAL RESERVATIONS INCLUDING MINERALS AND GEOTHERMAL RESOURCES, TO THE HIGHEST QUALIFIED BIDDER, STANFORD C. SHAW, AT THE CASH PRICE OF \$17,169.04.
