LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California and Humble Oil & Refining Company.

OPERATOR: Union Oil Company of California.

COUNTY: Santa Barbara.

AREA: Dos Pueblos offshore.

ISSUED: April 25, 1963.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:  
Drilled and abandoned eight wells.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS:  
From June 2, 1966, through June 1, 1970.

THIS DEFERMENT: From June 2, 1970, through June 1, 1971.

REASON FOR REQUEST:  
Plans for additional exploratory wells have been suspended pending the State's reconsideration of the offshore drilling moratorium.
