7. AUTHORIZATION FOR ISSUANCE OF ONE-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, 161.239-ACRE PARCEL OF UPLAND AND TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND AT PINOLE POINT, CITY OF RICHMOND, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT - W-8735, P.R.C. 4482.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 26 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO EAST BAY REGIONAL PARK DISTRICT OF A ONE-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, FROM JULY 15, 1970, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST. ## PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT:

East Bay Regional Park District.

LOCATION:

A 161.239-acre parcel of upland and tide and submerged land at Pinole Point adjoining Parchester Village, City of Richmond, lying between Giant Highway and the Southern Pacific Right of Way, and in San Francisco Bay, Contra Costa County.

LAND USE:

Park for public recreational purposes.

TERMS:

1 year, from July 15, 1970. Renewal option: 1 additional

period of 1 year.

Special: The permittee shall have the right to sublet said land or any part thereof, without prior consent from the State for public park and recreational purposes.

CONSIDERATION:

No charge. The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.
