APPROVAL OF A REVISED SET OF MAPS OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER IN THE VICINITY OF SACRAMENTO, SACRAMENTO AND YOLO COUNTIES - W 377 R.

A set of 12 maps entitled "Survey of the Ordinary High Water Mark Along the Sacramento River, Vicinity of Sacramento," W 377, was prepared by the State Lands Division in 1955 and approved by the State Lands Commission in May 1955. The elevation used for the ordinary high water mark shown on these maps was 3.50 feet above sea level datum of 1929 as published by the U. S. Department of Commerce in 1947. In 1965, the U. S. Department of Commerce published a revised elevation of 3.86 feet above sea level datum of 1929 for the mean high water tidal datum plane.

The set of 12 maps has now been revised (a draft copy of said revised set of 12 maps is attached hereto) to delete the identification of the surveyed line as an "ordinary high water mark". The surveyed line is now identified as a contour line that was surveyed at an elevation of 3.50 feet above sea level datum of 1929. It does not represent any tidal datum plane boundary line or water mark.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION CANCEL THE SUBJECT SET OF MAPS APPROVED IN MAY 1955, AND AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO APPROVE AND RECORD SHEETS 1 THROUGH 12 OF 12 OF SAID REVISED MAPS ENTITLED "1953 CONTOUR SURVEY WITHIN THE SACRAMENTO RIVER, VICINITY OF SACRAMENTO".
