THE COMMISSION:

- 1. FINDS THAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 41 ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, A DREDGING PERMIT AS RECOMENDED HEREIN WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT DETRIMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECT.

APPLICANT:

National Steel and Shipbuilding Company.

DREDGE LOCATION:

Tide and submerged lands (granted, with minerals reserved to the State, to San Diego Unified Port District) in San Diego Bay adjacent to the 28th Street Pier Mole, City of San Diego, San Diego County.

PURPOSE:

To provide a basin for new ship launching and to construct extensions to existing shipways.

DREDGE VOLUME:

107,000 cubic yards.

SPOIL/FILL LOCATIONS:

23,500 cubic yards to be spoiled at sea 3 miles west of Point Loma; 83,500 cubic yards to be used in shipway construction.

CONSIDERATION:

In the interest of the nation's shipping industry and \$0.10 per cubic yard royalty for all usable dredged material.
